“Hosting the Small Farm Dream” will help landowners explore approaches to creative partnerships with small farmers. Class exercises, peer-to-peer discussions, and presentations from local landowners and farmers will guide participants in deciding if a small farm project could thrive on their land. An optional networking reunion for course participants will provide the opportunity to connect with emerging farmers seeking land, as well as current landowner/farmer partners and helpful community resource people.

Each session (Wednesday, March 11 and Wednesday March 25) will run from 6:30-9 p.m. Participants must be able to attend both sessions and can expect four hours of home study between the two sessions. The optional networking reunion (Thursday, April 2) will begin at 6:30 p.m.
